

Get wise about leaf litter. Consider your options.

- 1. Mulch leaves in place with your lawn mower to put valuable nutrients back into your soil.**
- 2. Gather leaves and other “yard waste” into a compost pile, let overwinter and decompose, and then use as fertilizer next growing season.**
- 3. Offer your leaves to a neighbor who may be able to use them for composting.**
- 4. Properly dispose of leaves by taking them to the yard waste bins located at the DPW Facility at 185 Guelphwood Road. Brown paper bags only!**



Did you know?

The combination of rainfall with leaves on our driveways, sidewalks, streets, and parking lots can produce stormflows into local rivers, streams, and lakes that are loaded with harmful nutrients. Proper use or disposal of leaves will help to avoid these contaminated flows.
